

Rules and Regulations for the 2010 Lane County Livestock Association 8th Annual Club Calf & Heifer Sale

1. Entries for all cattle consigned must be received by the sale chairman by **September 15th 2010**. Late entries will be subject to a late fee of \$10.00 per head. Mail entries to

2. Weight Range and Requirements:

- Steers: Recommended weights of 450-700 lbs; Must be born after 1/1/10
- Heifers: Must be born after 9/1/09, may be registered purebreds or crossbreds of show quality

3. Animals must be halter broke to lead and tied with halter and neck rope for exhibition prior to the sale.

4. Animals must have an individual preconditioning statement submitted with entry.

5. Barn will be open to receive cattle from 4:00pm to 9:00pm Friday, October 8th 2010.

6. Animals will be vet checked at the weigh-in for quality and soundness. Disposition and condition will be considered. Unsound animals will be removed to a designated area of the fairgrounds or may go home. Unsound animals will not sell. Sale order will be random.

7. The animals will be weighed after arrival to the fairgrounds; this will be the official weight.

8. All calves are expected to be clipped and clean by 10:00am Saturday morning.

9. For entries received by the **15th of September**, the \$35.00 per head for Steers and Heifers will be refunded. A 10% sales commission will be assessed on all entries. Payments of all entry fees must be made in full prior to the sale. Should an animal not

sell, the secretary shall issue an animal release. All animals shall not be released prior to one hour after the conclusion of the sale, and must be removed by 7:00 pm Saturday. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Violation is subject to a \$100.00 fine. Consignors will pay for any registration fees.

10. There will be a sale brochure printed and available at sale time.

11. All animals will be sold by the head.

12. Consignors must be current members of the Lane County Livestock Association. Membership fee of \$15.00 may be withheld from proceeds if not paid at the time of entry. You may find the application on our website at www.lcla.org/membership_form.html

13. All animals shall be loaded and unloaded inside the approved area only. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

14. LCLA will mail checks to the consignor after 10 business days following the auction sale, less the auction commission and any and all costs mutually agreed upon.

15. Minimum vaccinations are: IBR, BVD, P13 & for Clostridial disease. All Heifers must have Brucellosis vaccination. All calves must have been dehorned and castrated early enough to have completely recovered by sale day.

16. Consignors must provide their own feed.

17. **LIABILITIES:** The LCLA is acting as a medium only between the buyer and seller. LCLA is not liable in any way whatsoever for any representations made by the seller. LCLA is not liable in any way for the failure on the part of the buyer and/or the seller to live up to his obligations. The buyer must look to the seller for fulfillment of all representations made hereunder.
